ART INSTRUCTION

Mixed Media Pop Art

Students design simple structures to create a pop art mixed media piece using popsicle sticks and a little inspiration from Spectrum Gallery's *Walls, Doors, & Fences* exhibit including the Gallery's front door.



Mini Gallery Exhibit

Taking their cue from modern and contemporary masterpieces, students build a mini gallery scene. They create mini works on canvas and a sculptural installation for their gallery walls and interior space assembling a three dimensional piece.



Mosaic Masterpiece

In small groups children create a mosaic masterpiece exploring a variety of papers to assemble a montage of color and movement. This collaborative effort will be exhibited in the gallery.

MOVING ART THURSDAY

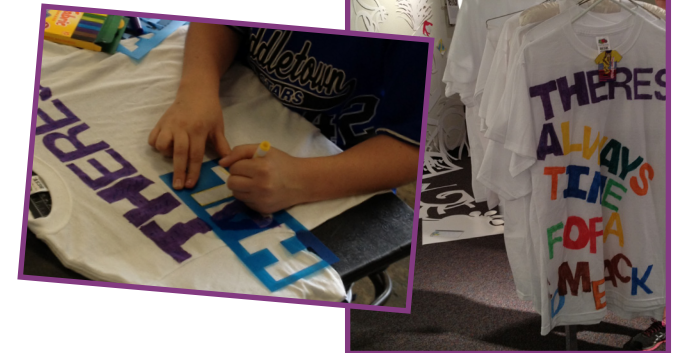
Performances at 12PM or 5PM

Moving Art Day focuses on basic concepts of movement and composition. Starting with a full body warm up children explore different qualities of movement with props and music learning about positive and negative spaces. They work together to shape their bodies into living sculptures! Both the morning and afternoon sessions conclude with an informal presentation of the children's dance creations. Wear clothing that allows freedom of movement. No shoes required. Please bring a daily water bottle.



TRUISMS: T-SHIRT DESIGN FRIDAY*

In these hands on workshops developed for young artists, children explore the artwork of American artist Jenny Holzer. Holzer uses text in her artwork, known as "Truisms," or one liners. Holzer's statements have been presented in projections, exhibitions, on posters, plaques, t-shirts, hats—and much more. These morning and afternoon workshops address how powerful words can be! Children look at examples of Holzer's art working in teams to develop text of their own. They produce a poster and a t-shirt based on their own Truisms understanding that text based works of art can be powerful vehicles of self-expression and communication.
